This tree survives difficult growing conditions but produces fewer high-quality nuts than most growers would prefer.

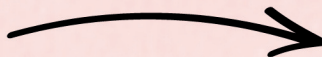

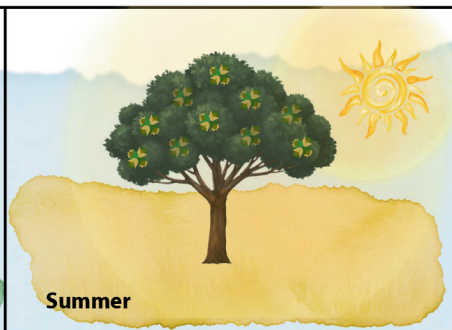
